Motivation

I come from Brazil and it makes me sad and angry how the politicians in my country treat our ecosystem. We humans live in a capitalist society where profit is the most important thing. Forests are being destroyed. The largest virgin forest in Latin America has shrunk by 85% in recent years. Illegal gold prospectors are polluting the Amazon jungle, there is illegal clearing in the Amazon to raise cattle or to plant soy plantations. It's time to be more conscious of our resources.

Since 2019, I have been in the artist group 'Forest and Storm' and we organise exhibitions. In my installations 'Landscape I to IV' I use industrially produced materials in order to give the viewer some thought to reflect on nature himself.
